As you know on February 9, 2022 an Administrative Order was filed to enhance the safety and security of the Stokes County Courthouse. A copy of this order is attached for reference. This order must be followed by anyone entering the Courthouse at any time. The Courthouse is occasionally used by private groups and these groups will need to coordinate with our Sheriff's Office to provide security for those events at their expense. The Sheriff's Office rate for this service is \$30 per hour for each Deputy provided with a minimum of two Deputies being required for any event at the Courthouse. Judge Puckett has requested that Teen Court remain in the courthouse with the county continuing to provide security. Since this is something that has not been done in the past I believe it would be appropriate for the Board of Commissioners to approve this as well as the rate.


ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
